Rush Township Trustees met in regular session on Monday, February 3, 2025 at 7:00 PM at the Township Building in North Lewisburg. Present were Cinda K. Bailey and Ed Funderburgh.

Ed called the meeting to order and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Old Business:

The Fiscal Officer reported that the paperwork to place the 0.500 mill Cemetery levy on the May 6 primary ballot was filed on January 22, 2025.

New Business:

The Trustees looked over the paperwork sent by the Champaign County Engineer concerning the 2025 Resurfacing Program. If the Trustees decide to chip and seal any of the township roads, the paperwork is due February 18, 2025. Any decisions were tabled and will be made at the next township meeting.

Ed gave a follow-up on the January 28 Appeals Court case in Dayton (Woodstock Solar Project vs. Rush Township Board of Zoning Appeals). He said that thirteen Rush Township residents attended the hearing. Each side had fifteen minutes to present their brief on the appeal. There were three judges and they will make their decision in a month or two.

It was reported that AES Ohio is currently constructing a new substation on Burton Rd. across the road from the current substation.

Randy Hunt reported that the rope is broken on the flag pole at Maple Grove Cemetery.

The next meeting will be held on Monday, February 17, 2025 at 7:00 PM.

Being no further business, Cinda made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ed.
