Andy moved to pay the bills, Ed seconded. All in favor. Fiscal officer instructed to issue warrants for the same.

Correspondence was gone over.

Old Business:

Cliff Hunter who resides at 10134 McCarty Rd., Woodstock asked the Trustees if something could be done with the high grass & weeds not being mowed at the property on 10118 McCarty Road. The Trustees told Mr. Hunter that a certified letter will be sent to the property owner deeming the property a nuisance and that the property owner will have seven days from receipt of the letter to clean up and mow the property.

Cemetery foundations were poured May 24. The fiscal officer presented a report that stated the receipts and expenses for these pourings.

Randy Hunt reported that DelMar Tree Service will be taking care of the trees in both cemeteries this week.

The fiscal officer reported that she has received notice from the auditing firm Perry & Associates that the audit for the years ending December 2019 & 2020 has been completed with no problems. The draft copy of the report will be sent to the State Auditor's office for final approval.

New Business:

Brad Herron presented a map to the Trustees with his request for splitting up some lots that he owns on Urbana Woodstock Pike. It was decided to ask Wayne Russell, Zoning Inspector of Goshen Township, to determine the preliminary approval to see if it meets zoning specifications or not.

Cinda reported that the web site launch is scheduled for this Friday, June 11.

Ed made a motion to request that the County Auditor certify to the Board of Trustees of Rush Township the total current tax valuation of the subdivision and the dollar amount of revenue that will be generated by the renewal of the 1.0 mills Road Levy. This levy expires at the end of tax year 2021. Andy seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. All in favor. Motion passed.

The next meeting will be held on Monday, June 21, 2021 at 7:00 PM.

Being no further business, Andy made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ed.
