Andy suggested that the resident clean out the ditch to get the water moving east towards Darby. The Trustees asked Randy Hunt to put down some berm gravel to fill in where the water has washed away some of the berm in the area.

Regarding the recent request to close off a street in Fountain Park, the Trustees agreed to keep the street as is and not abandon it as long as the resident uses it as a drive and maintains it.

New Business:

Cinda told the group that Cable Concrete sells military markers for \$30.00 each. She will order six.

Foundations were poured April 25, 2022. Monument companies will be notified of the pour.

Ed will speak to Champaign County Engineer Steve McCall again about cutting back on some of the work that needs to be done on McMahill Road.



The next meeting will be held on Monday, May 16, 2022 at 7:00 PM.


Being no further business, Andy made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Cinda.
