Rush Township Trustees met in regular session on Monday, June 21, 2021 at 7:00 PM at the Township Building in North Lewisburg. Present were Cinda Bailey, Ed Funderburgh and Andy Heath.

Cinda Bailey called the meeting to order. The minutes of the meetings held on June 7 and June 10, 2021 were approved as read.

Old Business:

A certified letter was mail to Doug Kelly on June 8, 2021. He signed that he received the letter on June 15. The letter stated that he has ten days upon receipt of the letter to mow and clean up his property at 10118 McCarty Rd., Woodstock or the township will hire someone to do it for him. As of today, he has not cleaned or mowed his property. Andy made a motion to spend \$250.00 to hire someone to mow the property. Ed seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. All in favor. Motion passed.

Cinda reported that she has spoken with Wayne Russell, Zoning Inspector of Goshen Township. He has looked at the lots that Brad Herron wants to split on Urbana Woodstock Pike and says the lots meet zoning specifications and can be split.

New Business:

Andy made a motion to place the 1.0 mill road levy as a renewal on the November 2, 2021 ballot. Ed seconded the motion. Roll call was taken. All in favor. Motion passed.

The fiscal officer passed out the 2022 Budget for Rush Township. She asked the Trustees to look the budget over as it will need to be passed at the July 5 township meeting as the approved budget needs to be sent to the County Auditor by July 20 (which is the day after the July 19 township meeting).

There was some discussion on the three water spigots in the older section of Maple Grove Cemetery not working. It was agreed that the cost to replace the water lines would be very expensive. The Trustees asked Randy Hunt to remove the inoperable hydrants and then cap the line at the underground base.

The next meeting will be held on Monday, July 5, 2021 at 7:00 PM.

Being no further business, Andy made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Ed.
