Andy reported that the tree cleanup at Woodstock Cemetery has been completed. Randy Hunt was asked to get some estimates for tree removal at both cemeteries.

Randy reported that he has been unsuccessful in contacting someone at Henderson concerning the hydraulic issue with the truck. Ed will call Henderson to get the situation taken care of.

New Business:

The fiscal officer reported that she received an email today from Otarma stating that they will be offering the \$500.00 MORE Grant again this year.

Ed reported that AES Ohio will begin tree trimming on their lines starting this week.

Randy reported that he is having trouble getting supplies for the Stihl chain saws. The Trustees asked him to check around for other chain saw options.
